- In order to eliminate duplicate judges, we ask that you work with us by notifying us before/after you have selected a judge. This can be done by contacting Cody Sloan- 816.649.8677. Please make sure to ask the potential judge if he has taken any other MCLB Series shows before asking them to judge your show to avoid duplicates.
- Please email us a flier of your show, or a link to the flier as soon as it is available, and promote our series in any way possible. Send this to sloan2005@hotmail.com.
- We ask that the shows please send us pictures of Winners for Advertising purposes on Facebook and our website.
- We ask that you allow our corporate sponsor to set up a booth at your show if they wish to promote their products.
- Any showman 21 years of age or under as of January 1 of the current year is able to exhibit.
- <u>WHAT WE NEED FROM YOU AFTER THE SHOW</u>: A list of the classes that includes showman name, Scrapie tag number of the animal, and placing in the class. A copy of the classes with placings out to the side works great. PLEASE, MAKE SURE TO USE SHEEP SCRAPIE TAG NUMBERS AND NOTHING ELSE.
- Showmanship Show
 - Divided into two divisions: 13 and Under and 14 and over (as of Jan 1)
 - If you need to have "heats" for showmanship because of large class sizes, that is fine, just <u>make sure to get</u> us a list of ALL of the participants- even the ones that didn't make the top 10. WE MUST HAVE A TOP TEN OVERALL FOR EACH AGE DIVISON (unless less than 10 Participate)
- Market Lamb Show
 - All market lambs can be ewes or wethers and must have lamb teeth
 - Market lambs are shown by weight only- NOT by breed divisions.
 - \circ All classes must be placed from top to bottom by the judge for points tracking purposes.
 - (NEW IN 2016) MARKET CLASSES NEED TO CONSIST OF 6-8 HEAD for points purposes.
- Wether Dam Show
 - Both ewe lambs and yearling wether dams are eligible.
 - o Lambs are shown by weight, yearlings will show in a single yearling class. NO BREED DIVISIONS
 - All classes must be placed top to bottom
 - (NEW IN 2016) W. DAM CLASSES NEED TO CONSIST OF 3-5 HEAD for points purposes.
